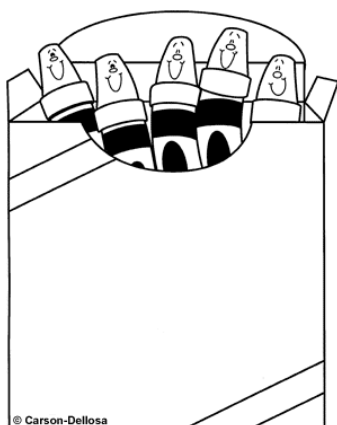

The 2016-2017 school year will be my 5th year in Preschool and my 11th year at St. Joseph Catholic School. I am very excited to begin a new year in Preschool!

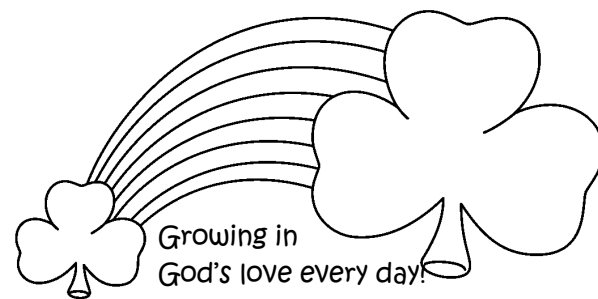
Miss Anita and Miss Toni have both been teacher aides for many years at St. Joseph School. This is their 6th year in our Preschool.

Fantastic Fours

- ♣ The child must be 4 years old before October 1st.
- ♣ Sessions will be held on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 8:30 AM until 11:00 AM. (The AM drop off time will be 8 AM to 8:30 AM.)
- ♣ Tuition for the 2015-2016 school year was ten payments of \$102.50 a month (August - May) or \$1,025 for the school year. Tuition may be slightly higher for the 2016-2017 school year.
