Math: Please do the Snow Flake Fun worksheet.

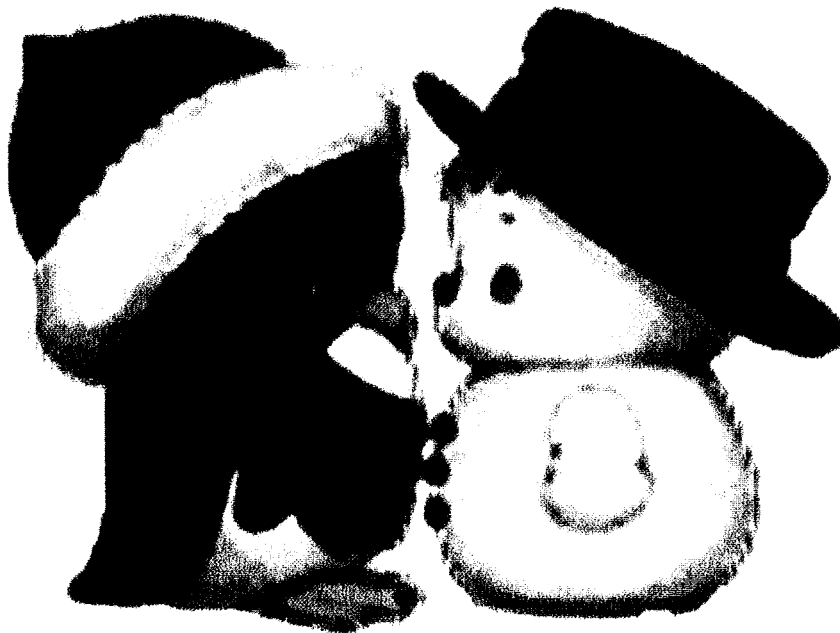
Religion: Please do the worksheet “Heart: Love From Others.”

Science: Do the “Melting Snow” science experiment. Fold the pages down the middle and fill in the booklet as you go.

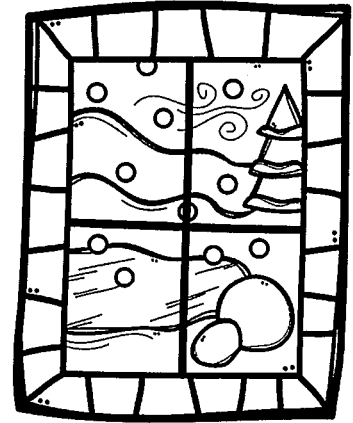
