Writing: Please write a journal page with at least 2 complete sentences telling me something you did today. Please draw a picture as well. Remember to use upper and lower case letters and periods.

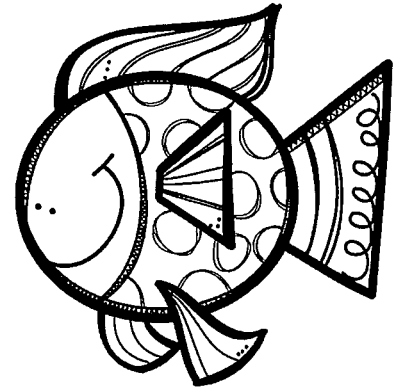
Science or Social Studies: You can pick ONE of the following assignments or one of the science or social studies assignments from previous packets that you have not yet done.

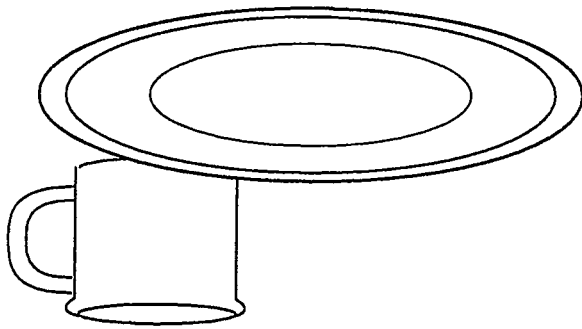

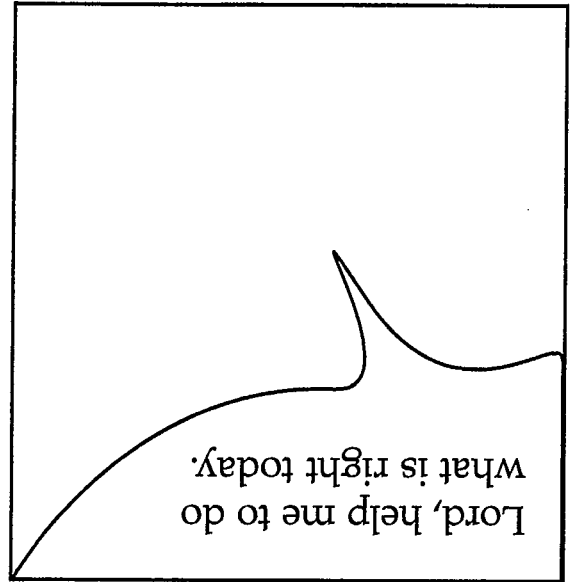

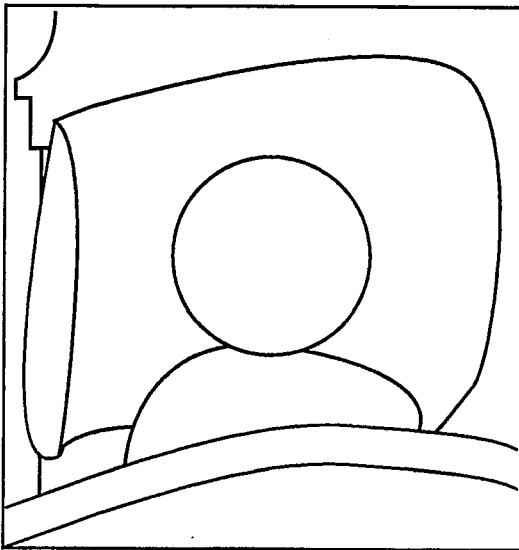

It might be fun to see a live Tyrannosaurus rex, but I wouldn't want to meet one. Would you?

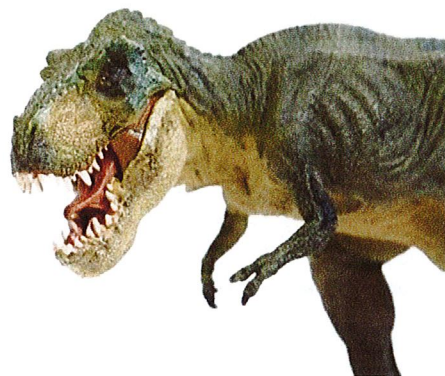

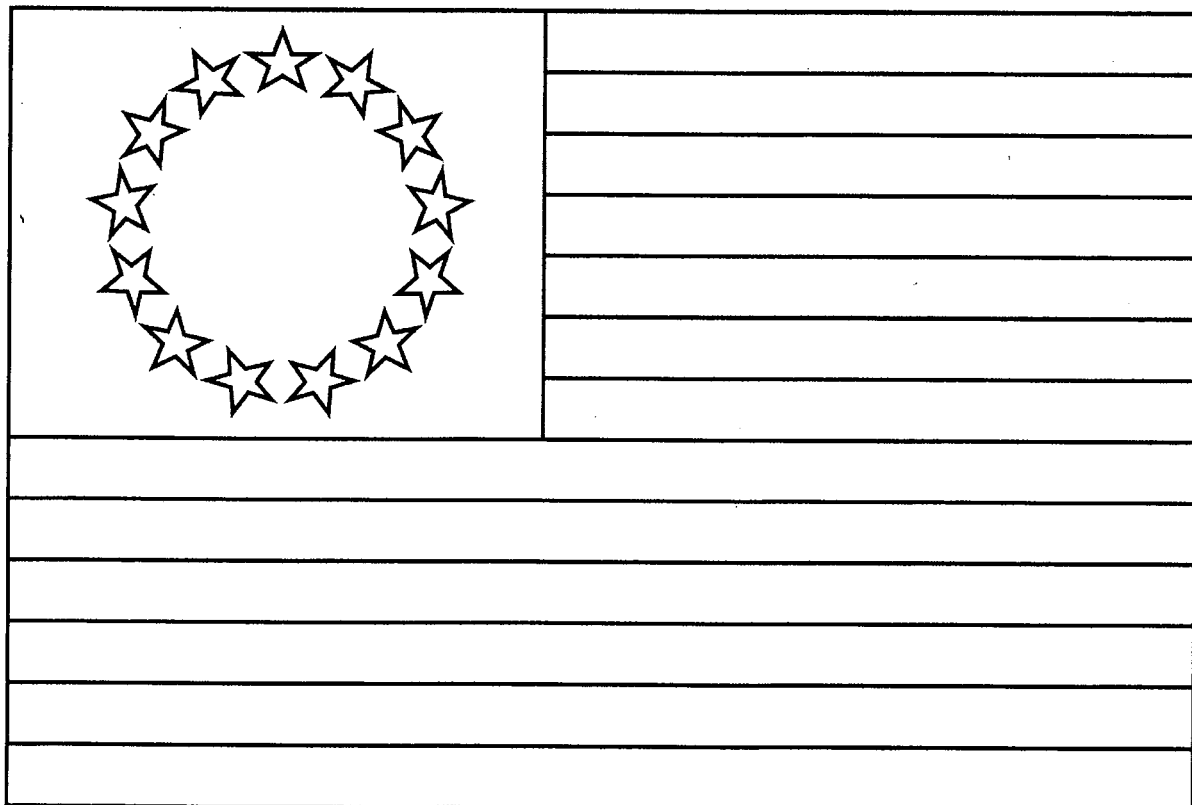

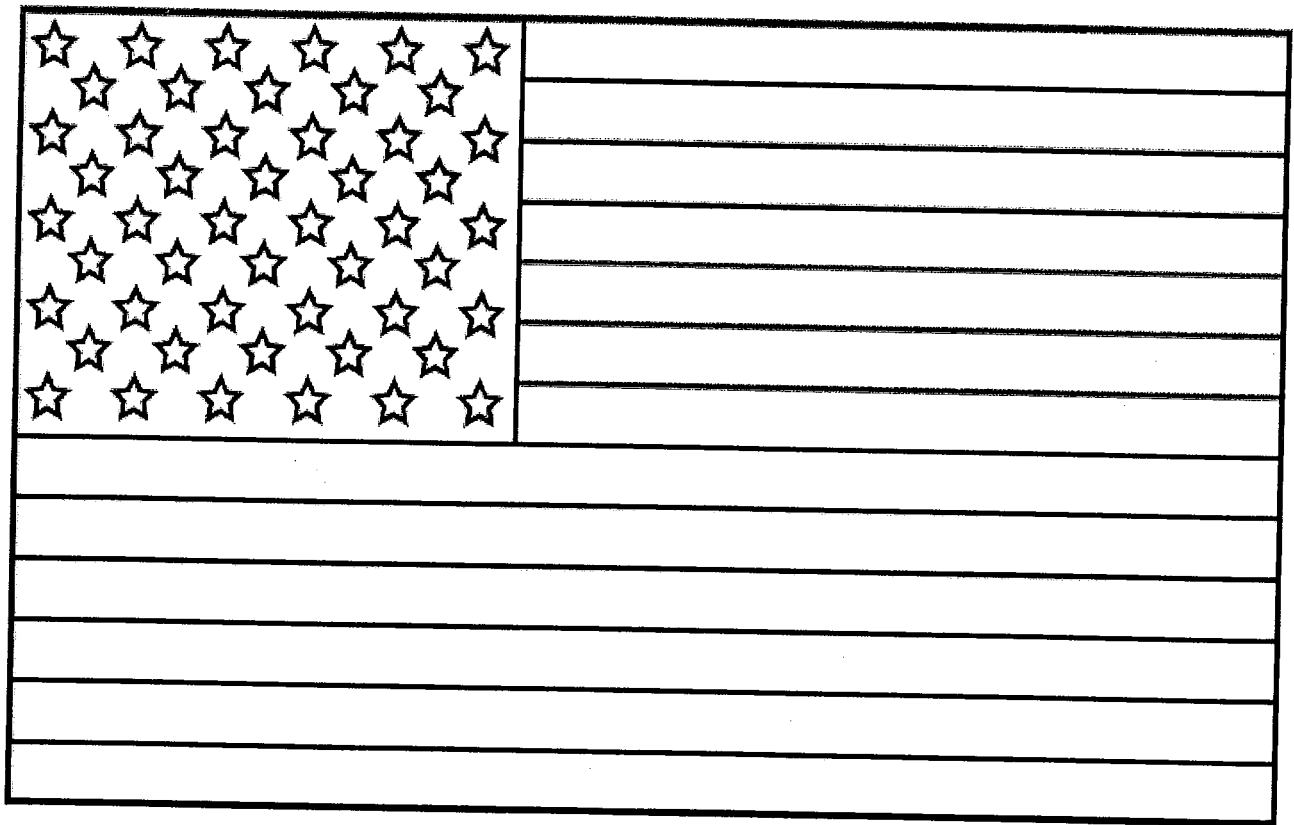
First Flag of the United States of America
